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Monthly deliveries When blessings, commitment, and hard work join, the result, will be securing high quality medical care to patients and safety of staff. This exactly what happened this month, three symptomatic woman arrived at the Triage Area of Holy Family Hospital and were diagnosed by the Nurse to be possible infected with COVID19. Full protection was taken while receiving full medical care at the hospital and a swab were taken during their admission that resulted to be positive to COVID19. One additional case was already diagnosed with COVID 19 before admission to the hospital and the patient informed the staff at the entrance. Only one staff among those who provided the needed medical care to these women caught the infection.

Another month passed over hiding behind the walls of Holy Family Hospital, little stories and moments that will change and affect our life for ever.

A total of 372 babies were born in October and 30 babies were admitted to the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit. 33 were discharged from the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit and joined their family in good health.

Being a parent of multiples is a job that requires a strong person with a strong conviction to get through each phase. One of those phases that many twin parents go through after giving birth is the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit. This is often an unfamiliar place for many parents, full of alarm, worries and uncertainty.

"Congratulations, you are pregnant with twins", So much Emotion hearing that. Hayat, 25 years old from Bethlehem a Housewife holding a BA Accounting, married since 2015. Her husband, Amar, a Taxi driver, they have one boy and a girl who were born previously at Holy Family Hospital.

Hayat received all the prenatal check-ups and delivered at the governmental hospital due to financial issues.

On September 29, 2020 at 31 weeks of pregnancy Hayat Gave birth to her twin girls Renas and Remas. Renas weighed 1.425 kg, and Remas Weighed 1.640 kg, both needed Intensive care and as agreed between the Governmental Hospital and Holy Family Hospital. All premature below the 32weeks requiring intensive care are transferred to Holy Family Hospital Intensive care unit since

this is the only high specialized unit capable of treating these little premature.


Dr. Jeries graduated from College de frères in Bethlehem and received his Degree in Medicine from Al Najah National University in Nablus/ Palestine.
